




Messe Frankfurt 2016: A global player in the trade fair sector



- Organiser of 134 trade fairs worldwide
- Shareholders: City of Frankfurt (60%),
 State of Hesse (40%)
- 28 subsidiaries worldwide and more than
 50 international Sales Partners covering
 178 countries
- Turnover: EUR 646.7 million
- About 90,000 exhibitors and about 3.5 million visitors
- Total area: 592,127 m²
 - available hall space: 366.637 m²
 - available open space: 96,078 m²



Built in **1909** as an unsupported classicist domed construction in steel and glass

Architect: Friedrich von Thiersch

1986 conversion costing more than DM 40 million into a **modern multi-purpose hall**

Exhibition area in the hall: **5,600** m², space for up to **13,500 people** Can be used in combination with other buildings or separately


- Architect: Nicholas Grimshaw

- Inauguration: 2001

- Trussless roof span up to 15 metres high
- Two event levels with 38,000 m² of gross exhibition space
- Plus 2,300 m² of foyer, 1,500 m² of storage and 2,900 m² of office/conference area

 1,500 m² of storage and
 2,900 m² of office/conference area

- Spacious areas: a total of 79,500 m² usable area




Ground Development – view to Hall 12



Hall 12 in the south-western part of the exhibition centre. Construction period: 2016 – 2018




The two-storey hall designed by kadawittfeldarchitektur GmbH will be inaugurated in time for Automechanika 2018. The building will be approx. 248 metres long, 118 metres wide and approximately 30 metres high. Exhibition space will be around 33,600 gross square metres in total.






Plans and layouts



Easy divisibility and spaces that can be utilized independently of one another: functionality and flexibility are the characteristic features of both exhibition levels in hall 12. A roof-mounted photovoltaic system supplies one-fifth of the building's base load.
